

# The Corporation of the Town of Minto

## By-Law Number 99-46

Being a By-Law to regulate the time, manner, extent and nature of the supply of water within the Town of Minto


WHEREAS it is provided by Section 12 of the Public Utilities Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 12, that the Corporation may pass by-laws for regulating the time, manner, extent and nature of the supply of water and every other matter or thing related to or connected therewith that it may be necessary or proper to regulate, in order to secure to the inhabitants of the municipality a continued and abundant supply of pure and wholesome water;

AND WHEREAS it is in the interest of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Minto to enact a by-law for the residents supplied by a municipal water supply;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Minto enacts as follows:


1. Whenever, in the Council's opinion, public necessity may require such action, it may take such measures as it deems necessary to regulate or suspend any or all use of water through a hose or other attachment, or for use for street, lawn or garden sprinkling or for any fountain or for any purpose whatsoever.
2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the watering or sprinkling of any lawn or garden in the Town of Minto through a hose or other attachment is subject to the following regulations:
  - a) Watering of lawns, flowers and gardens will only be allowed by a hand held sprinkler.
  - b) Premises having an odd house number may water only on days having an odd number or date.
  - c) Premises having an even house number may water only on days having an even number or date.
  - d) Watering of lawns, flowers and gardens is only permitted between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on the aforementioned days.
  - e) New lawns, seeded or sodded may be watered by a sprinkler between 7 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on even numbered days for even numbered houses and odd numbered days for odd numbered houses. The owner must first apply to the Town of Minto Administration Office for an extended hours watering permit.
3. Every person who contravenes any provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$300.00 exclusive of costs.
4. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign this By-Law.
5. That the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to affix the Corporate Seal hereto.
6. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect as of the date of its final passing.


