

Town of Minto Arenas
COVID – 19 - Rules for the Use of the Arenas by Leagues, Teams and Individuals

These rules are to ensure the safety of all users and to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Entrance Restrictions and Requirements

- If you are experiencing any of the following you are prohibited from using the arena:
 - Symptoms of COVID-19 as listed on Health Unit website
 - Close contact with a confirmed or probably COVID-19 case
 - Travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days
 - Instructions from local public health authorities to self-isolate due to travel or contact history
- Access at one time and leagues are restricted to up to 50 participants
- Access to the arena will be up to 15 minutes before and 15 minutes after rental
- Attendance to be taken nightly by renter (in case close-contact tracing is required)
- Participants are asked to come as dressed as possible
- Dressing rooms will be available for up to 6 participants per room
- Dressing room showers and washrooms will not be available
- Auditoriums when available will be used as a heated waiting and dressing areas
- Bookings must be approved by the Town of Minto Recreation Department
- Ice times will be buffered if needed to ensue less than 50 people are present concurrently
- No food or drink except non-alcoholic drinks for participants while participating
- Follow protocols required by the Province, Health Unit, and any other regulatory body

Physical Distancing

- Maintain a distance of at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other people when possible
- No handshaking, socializing after the rental and unnecessary physical contact

Equipment & Structures and Objects

- The structures and objects in and around this amenity are being cleaned and sanitized regularly

Hand Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer is in place at the arenas
- Hands should be wiped clean before applying the hand sanitizer
- Perform hand hygiene: 1) Upon arrival; 2) Upon leaving

Use of Non-Medical (homemade masks)

- Wearing a non-medical mask (handmade cloth mask) or facial covering is required when entering and moving about the arena; it can be removed during the activity

Subject to Change

- These rules are subject to change
- The arenas may be closed if unsafe social distancing is observed

Assumption of Risk

- By visiting any arenas and publicly accessible spaces you voluntarily assume all risks including any risk of injury, loss, damage, and possible exposure to a communicable disease, including COVID-19
