COVID – 19 - Rules for the Use of the Shuffleboard Courts

These rules are to ensure the safety of all users and to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Entrance Restrictions and Requirements

- If you are experiencing any of the following you are prohibited from using the courts:
 - Symptoms of COVID-19 as listed on Health Unit website
 - Close contact with a confirmed or probably COVID-19 case
 - Travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days
 - Instructions from local public health authorities to self-isolate due to travel or contact history
- Access is restricted to up to 10 participants for drop-in
- Sign-in required upon arrival (in case close-contact tracing is required)
- No pets (unless service animals) at the courts
- Follow protocols required by the Province, Health Unit, and any other regulatory body

Physical Distancing

- Maintain a distance of at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other people (excluding members of the same household)

Equipment & Structures and Objects

- The designated Host will set out equipment required to play
- The designated Host will clean equipment with disinfectant wipes after each session
- The structures and objects in and around this amenity are not being sanitized

Hand Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer is in place at the courts
- Hands should be wiped clean before applying the hand sanitizer
- Perform hand hygiene: 1) Upon entering the courts; 2) Upon leaving the courts

Use of Non-Medical (homemade masks)

- Wearing a non-medical mask (handmade cloth mask) or facial covering is encouraged for this type of activity

Subject to Change

- These rules are subject to change
- The courts may be closed if unsafe social distancing is observed

Assumption of Risk

- By visiting any parks and publicly accessible spaces you voluntarily assume all risks including any risk of injury, loss, damage, and possible exposure to a communicable disease, including COVID-19
