COVID - 19 - Rules for the Use of the Indoor Walking Areas

These rules are to ensure the safety of all users and to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Entrance Restrictions and Requirements

- If you are experiencing any of the following you are prohibited from using the areas:
 - Symptoms of COVID-19 as listed on Health Unit website
 - Close contact with a confirmed or probably COVID-19 case
 - Travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days
 - Instructions from local public health authorities to self-isolate due to travel or contact history
- Access is restricted to up to 10 participants
- Registration is required before attending the program
- No pets (unless service animals) at the areas
- Follow protocols required by the Province, Health Unit, and any other regulatory body

Physical Distancing

- Maintain a distance of at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other people (excluding members of the same household)
- Walk in the same clockwise or counterclockwise direction

Equipment & Structures and Objects

- The structures and objects in and around these areas are not being sanitized

Hand Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer is in place at the areas
- Hands should be wiped clean before applying the hand sanitizer
- Perform hand hygiene: 1) Upon entering the areas; 2) Upon leaving the areas

Use of Non-Medical (homemade masks)

- Wearing a non-medical mask (handmade cloth mask) or facial covering is required at all times

Subject to Change

- These rules are subject to change
- The areas may be closed if unsafe social distancing is observed

Assumption of Risk

By visiting any parks and publicly accessible spaces you voluntarily assume all risks including any risk of injury, loss, damage, and possible exposure to a communicable disease, including COVID-19
